Betreft / Concerne: admission standards for the national team 2011 / 2012

Skaters who want to be part of the national team for the season 2011-2012 needs to have obtained at least once at the following a-competitions: Belgian nationals, Kempen Trophy and flemish and Walloon regionals the following points:

Senior Ladies:	minimum 100 points
Senior Men:	minimum 130 points
Junior Ladies	minimum 80 points
Junior Men:	minimum 85 points
Advanced novices Girls:	minimum 60 points
Advanced novices Boys:	minimum 65 points

Members of the current national team who obtained these points at ISU-listed competitions can use this points as qualification rule for the next national team.

If a skater obtains the points at an a competition during the season, he/she will be asked if he/she wants to be part of the national team from the moment of obtaining the points;

Skaters of the national team who want to be send out by the national federation to EC of WC have to skate a free program with at least the following minimum points:

- Men: minimum: free program of 90 points
- Ladies: minimum: free program of 68 points

For the season 2012-2013 the same rule/points will apply.
